- (1) Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that Tahsildar, Dhamdha, District Durg has issued notice to the petitioner staying the construction made by him, which is not in accordance with law.
- (2) Per contra, counsel for the State would submit that the petitioner may file reply to the said notice and that will be considered and decided strictly in accordance with law.
- (3) I have heard learned counsel appearing for the parties.
- (4) Be that as it may, the petitioner is at liberty to file reply / objection to the said notice within a period of two weeks from today before the Tahsildar, Dhamdha, that will be considered and decided strictly in accordance with law expeditiously preferably within a

further period of three weeks from the receipt thereof

- (5) For the period of five weeks, interim granted earlier shall remain in operation.
- (6) With the aforesaid observations, the writ petition stands finally disposed of.
