1. Heard on the application filed under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. This is second bail application before this Court filed by the applicant for grant of regular bail. His first bail application was dismissed as withdrawn. The applicant has been arrested on 26-10-2017 in connection with Crime No.325/2017 registered at P.S. Simga, District Balodabazar-Bhatapara Chhattisgarh for the offence under Section 34(2) of the C.G. Excise Act and 420 of the IPC.

2. It is submitted on behalf of the applicant that the applicant has been falsely implicated in this case. He is in custody since 26-10-2017. Hence, he may be enlarged on bail.

3. Learned counsel for the State/non-applicant opposes the application and submission. It is submitted that in total 6.840 bulk liter Goa whisky has been seized from the possession of the applicant. Also, earlier proceeding under Section 110 of the Cr.P.C. is reported against this applicant. Hence, he is not entitled for grant of bail.

4. Heard learned counsel for both the parties and perused the case diary.

5. Considering the submissions made and the contents of the case diary, detention of the applicant till conclusion of the trial would not serve any purpose. Hence, for these reasons the application deserves to be allowed.

6. Consequently, this application filed by the applicant under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail is hereby allowed. It is directed that the applicant shall be released on bail on his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs.25,000/- with one surety in the like sum to the satisfaction of the concerned Court, for his appearance as and when directed.
