3. Be that as it may, petitioner is at liberty to approach the Collector / Land Acquisition Officer, Janjgir Champa for disbursement of amount of compensation within two weeks from today and if such a representation is made before the Collector / Land Acquisition Officer, Janjgir Champa, then

the said authorities shall consider and decide the petitioner's representation for grant of compensation strictly in accordance with law expeditiously preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of copy of representation.

4. With the aforesaid observation, the writ petition stands finally disposed of. No order as to cost(s).
