2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent – State would submit that the order of Collector is revisable before the Divisional Commissioner (R).

Be that as it may, the petitioner would be at liberty to file a representation before the Divisional Commissioner(R) within a period of two weeks from today and, in turn, the said authority shall consider and decide the petitioner's representation expeditiously preferably within a period of three months from date of receipt of representation along with certified copy of this order after hearing the parties.
