Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that against the order dated 25.09.2012, revision preferred by respondent No. 9 before respondent No. 2 under Section 50 of the Chhattisgarh Land Revenue Code, 1959 is pending consideration since 12.10.2012 in which the petitioner is a party and the interim order is operating against him since then but the Board of Revenue has not taken any final decision till date.
2. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through the records with utmost circumspection.
