At this juncture, without entering into the merits of the case, this Court is of the opinion that ends of justice would meet if the petition is disposed off with a direction to the respondent No.2 to consider the case of the petitioners and to pass a suitable order in accordance with the rules governing the service conditions of the petitioners so far as confirming their regularization.
4. It is expected that the authorities would take a decision expeditiously preferably within a period of 90 days. The Writ Petition stands disposed off.
