(3) Be that as it may, the Collector, Rajnandgaon is directed to consider and dispose of the proceedings expeditiously preferably within

a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of copy of this order. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to make an additional representation to the Collector, Rajnandgaon for redressal of his grievances, if any.

(4) With the aforesaid direction, the writ petition stands disposed of.
