1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite a report being made on 29.08.2017 to the police wherein cognizable offence has been reported, nothing has transpired and police has not registered the FIR.
2. Perused the written report Annexure P-1 which bears the seal of the police authorities to have received the same, therefore, in view of the law laid down by the Supreme Court in **Ram Lal Narang v. State (Delhi Admn.) (AIR 1979 SC 1791)** and **Lalita Kumari v. Government of Uttar Pradesh**

and Others {(2014) 2 SCC 1} wherein it has been held that in such complaints/FIR disclosing commission of cognizable offence, the concerned police shall register the FIR, complete the investigation within a reasonable time, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the concerned police to proceed in accordance with law and do the needful for completing the investigation at the earliest.
