Heard on application for restoration of Writ Petition (227) No. 3034 of 2010.

2. The applicant is seeking restoration of Writ Petition (227) No. 3034 of 2010 which was dismissed by this Court for want of prosecution vide order dated 07.12.2017.

3. On due consideration of the submissions made by the learned counsel for the applicant and the grounds taken in the restoration petition, I am satisfied that the absence of the applicant's counsel on 07.12.2017, when the Writ Petition (227) No. 3034 of 2010 was taken up for hearing, was based on *bonafide* grounds.

4. The M.C.C. No. 16 of 2018 is, therefore, allowed and the Writ Petition

(227) No. 3034 of 2010 is restored to its original number subject to payment of cost of Rs.3000/- (Three Thousand Only) to the High Court Legal Aid Committee within ten days from today.

5. It is made clear that the M.C.C. is restored without the interim order. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to file a fresh application for interim order, if any.
