1. This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner against the order dated 28.02.2018 (Annexure – P/1) passed by respondent No. 2- Nazul Officer, Durg rejecting the petitioner's application /representation.
2. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the impugned order passed is unsustainable and bad in law and is liable to be set aside.
3. On the other hand, learned counsel appearing for respondent / State would submit that representation preferred by the petitioner would lie before the Commissioner, Durg Division.
