1. Heard on the application filed under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. This is first bail application before this Court filed by the applicant for grant of regular bail. The applicant has been arrested on 22-03-2018 in connection with Crime No.38/2018 registered at P.S. Patewa, District- Mahasamund, Chhattisgarh for the offence under Section 34(2) of the C.G. Excise Act.
2. It is submitted on behalf of the applicant that the applicant has been falsely implicated in this case. He is in custody since 22-03-2018. Hence, he may be released on bail.
3. Learned counsel for the State/non-applicant opposes the application and submission. It is submitted that in total 20 bulk liter illicit liquor has been seized from the possession of the applicant. Also, there is criminal antecedent of this applicant, in which, one case is under the provision of the IPC and two proceedings of preventive nature under the provisions of the Cr.P.C. Hence, he is not entitled for grant of bail.
4. Heard learned counsel for both the parties and perused the case diary.

5. Considered on the submissions made and contents of the case diary. Though one previous case under the provisions of the IPC has been reported against the applicant, but there is no previous case for the similar offence registered against the applicant, further in the present matter detention of the applicant till conclusion of the trial would not serve any purpose. Hence, for these reasons the application deserves to be allowed.

6. Consequently, this application filed by the applicant under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail is hereby allowed. It is directed that the applicant shall be released on bail on his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs.25,000/- with one surety in the like sum to the satisfaction of the concerned Court, for his appearance as and when directed.
