3. Be that as it may, the petitioner is at liberty to make representation

before the Collector, Raigarh for disbursement of the award of compensation and, in turn, the said authority shall consider and dispose of the petitioner's representation expeditiously preferably within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order after hearing the parties.

4. With the aforesaid observation, the writ petition stands finally disposed of. No order as to cost(s).
