1. This is the first bail application seeking for grant of bail to the Applicant who is in jail since 06.08.2017 in connection with Crime No. 80 of 2017 registered at Police Station Jashpur for the offence punishable under Sections 457 and 380/34 IPC.
2. As per prosecution case, the applicant is said to have entered into the shop of Ajay Gupta and is said to have stolen clothes like Jeans Pant and other dress materials and also cash worth Rs.3000-4000 from the shop.
3. Learned Counsel for the applicant submits that it is a case where the applicant has remained in custody for more than 10 months and that the nature of offence is petty and therefore the present applicant be released on bail.
4. The State counsel opposing the application submits that it is a case where the applicant is a habitual offender and there are around 17-

18 criminal cases against the applicant and large number of them are that of theft cases.

5. Given the facts and circumstances of the case, particularly taking note of the part history of the applicant, this court is not inclined to release the applicant on bail. Accordingly, the bail application stands rejected.
