The challenge in the present writ petition is to the order of suspension dated 01.05.2018 whereby the services of the petitioner have been placed under suspension.

2. At the outset, this Court is of the opinion that the present writ petition may not be sustainable on account of having an alternative statutory remedy of appeal available to the petitioner. The appeal against the impugned order of suspension lies before the Board of Director.
