(1) The accused/applicant has moved this fourth bail application under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for releasing him on regular bail during trial in connection with Crime No. 780/2015 registered at Police Station Civil Line, District Bilaspur for the offence punishable under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code. The applicant's earlier three bail applications were dismissed on merits as well as dismissed as withdrawn.
