1. The petitioner has preferred this writ petition to direct respondent authorities to consider and decide his pending representation dated

28.08.2017 for grant of Special Piece Rate Allowance in the light of National Coal Wage Agreement, which is still pending for consideration before the respondent authorities till this date.
