He submits that at village Bhathri, he has 40 dismil land, which too were mortgaged by Rubel Kumar Mashih respondent herein for Rs.30,000/-. Perused the report of the State wherein it is stated that the applicant is receiving Rs.35,000/- per year and he is a labour. Taking into totality of the facts and statement, the application under Order 44 Rule 1 of C.P.C. is allowed. The applicant is allowed to contest the appeal as an indigent person.
