Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that petitioner has filed an application under Section 10(4) of the Chhattisgarh Underground Pipelines (Acquisition of Right of User in Land) Act, 2004 [for brevity, 'Act of 2004'] which is pending before the competent authority / Sub-Divisional Officer (Revenue) since 06.11.2017 and has not been considered and decided till date.

Be that as it may, the competent authority is directed to consider and decide the petitioner's application filed under Section 10(4) of the Act of 2004 after hearing the parties expeditiously, preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
