2. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that deduction made by the authorities is illegal.

Be that as it may, the petitioner is at liberty to make a representation to the Collector, Sukma, who in turn, shall consider the same after hearing all affected parties as provided in clause 10 of the NIT issued for the year 2016-17, preferably within a period of 6 weeks from the date of its receipt along with certified copy of this order.

4. With the aforesaid observation, the writ petition finally stands disposed of. No cost(s).
