Counsel for the respondent No.2 submits that entire selection process have been concluded and all the selected candidates have already been granted appointment. In view of the same, this court is of the opinion that no fruitful purpose would be served in keeping this petition pending. Further, it appears that none of the selected candidates have been made party in the petition.
