1. This is first bail application under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. preferred by the applicant before this Court and his no bail application is pending before any other court.
2. The applicant has been arrested in connection with Crime No. 302/2018 registered in police station Takhatpur, Distt. Bilaspur (CG) for offence punishable under Section 34(2) of the CG Excise Act.
3. Prosecution story in brief is that on 31-7-2018, 6.5 bulk litre hand made country liquor has been seized from the applicant.
4. Counsel for the applicant argued that the applicant is innocent and has been falsely implicated hence he be released on bail.
5. On the other hand, the State Counsel opposed the bail application. He further submits that no criminal antecedent has been reported against him in the police case diary.
6. Looking to the above facts and circumstances of the case, the application is allowed. It is ordered that if the applicant furnishes one solvent surety for a sum of Rs. 25,000/- along with one personal bond of the 25,000/- to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned, he be released on bail.
