The claim of the petitioner is that though the land of the petitioner was acquired by the respondents for mining purposes and the petitioner under the rehabilitation policy was entitled for employment being the land oustee but his case has not been considered by the respondents till date and it is only recently the State Govt. has published the list whereby it has been held

that the petitioner was also entitled for employment.

2. Without expressing anything on the merits of the case so far as the entitlement of the petitioner is concerned, this Court does not want to keep the petition pending rather ends of justice would serve if the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 to take a decision on the entitlement of the petitioner. If the petitioner is entitled for then an appropriate order be passed in this regard and if he is not entitled for any relief even then an appropriate order be passed intimating the petitioner that he is not entitled for whatsoever reasons under the guidelines and rules governing the field.

3. With the aforesaid observation, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
