1. The challenge in the present Writ Petition is to the order Annexure-P/1 dated 31/07/2018 whereby the petitioner has been transferred from Durg (C.G.) to Newjalpaigudi (W.B.) in the light of pendency of criminal case.
2. The counsel for the petitioner had assailed the impugned order on the ground that, the criminal case has already stands decided and the petitioner

stands acquitted in the criminal case which fact perhaps has not been taken note by the respondents.
