(1) This writ petition has been filed against the order dated 07.08.2018 passed by Chhattisgarh Waqf Tribunal, Raipur, in MJC Case No. 16/2017 restoring the application filed by respondent No.1 under Section 83(2) and 94 of the Waqf Act, 1995 to its original number by allowing the application under Order 9 Rule 9 of the Code of Civil Procedure filed by him.
