1. The counsel for the respondent submits that, there is a provision of appeal available to the petitioner to challenge the order of punishment – Annexure-P/1.
2. The grievance of the petitioner in the instant Writ Petition is to the orders Annexure P/1, P/2 and P/3 dated 06.01.2017, 07.06.2017 and 20.07.2017 respectively.
3. The counsel for the respondent submits that, let the petitioner prefer an appeal against the impugned order to the Appellate Authority and the Appellate Authority shall decide the appeal within a period of 30 days from the date of filing of the appeal.
4. Without expressing any opinion on merits, the present Writ Petition stands disposed off with a direction to the petitioner to prefer an

appeal within a period of 15 days from today and the Appellate Authority shall positively decide the appeal within a further period of 45 days thereafter.

5. The Writ Petition accordingly stands disposed off.
