Hon'ble Shri Justice Ram Prasanna Sharma**Order on Board****12-11-2018.**

1. This is first bail application filed under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the applicant, who has been arrested on 24-7-2018 in connection with Crime No. 225 of 2018 registered at Police Station D.D. Nagar, District Raipur (CG), for the offence punishable under Sections 380 and 436 of IPC.
2. As per case of prosecution, shop of one Rajesh Yadu caught fire and it was found that the computer and other articles were stolen from the said shop and thereby the aforesaid offence was committed.
3. Learned counsel appearing for the applicant would submit that there is no *prima facie* case against the present applicant and he is permanent resident of the address mentioned in the

application, trial will take sufficient time to conclude and there is no likelihood of absconding of the applicant, therefore, he should be enlarged on bail.

4. On the other hand, learned State counsel opposes the application for grant of bail.
5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the case diary.
6. Looking to the fact that there is no expert opinion reading cause of fire and further looking to the fact that the trial I will take some time to conclude, I am inclined to release the applicant on bail.
7. Accordingly, the bail application filed under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. is allowed and it is directed that the applicant shall be released on bail on his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs.25,000/- with one local surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court. He shall appear before the trial Court regularly on each and every date, unless exempted from appearance.
