1. This is the first bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail as the Applicant is arrested in connection with Crime No.1220/2018 registered at Police Station – Kotwali, District Raigarh (CG) for the offence punishable under Sections 34(1)(a)(2) and 59(A) of Chhattisgarh Excise Act for illegally possessing 6.480 bulk liters of country made liquor.

2. Case of the prosecution is that on the basis of a secret information, a search was made on 13.09.2018 in which, 6.480 bulk liters of country made liquor was recovered from the possession of the Applicant. Based upon it, the alleged offence as mentioned above has been registered against the Applicant.

3. Learned Counsel for the Applicant submits that the Applicant is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the alleged crime. She further submits that the Applicant is in jail since 13.09.2018, therefore, he is liable to be enlarged on bail.

4. On the other hand, learned counsel for the State while opposing the prayer for bail, submits that the offence is of serious in nature and the alleged country made liquor was recovered from the possession of the Applicant therefore, the bail application deserves to be rejected.

5. Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case and particularly keeping in view the quantity of liquor seized and that the Applicant is in jail since 13.09.2018, this Court is inclined to release the Applicant on bail. Accordingly, the bail application filed under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C is allowed and it is directed that the Applicant shall be released on bail on his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like sum to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court. He shall also appear before the trial Court as and when directed.
