Heard.

(1) The accused/applicant has moved this second bail application under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for releasing him on regular bail during trial in connection with Crime No. 09/2015 registered at Police Station Economic Offence Wing/Anti Corruption Bureau, Raipur for the offence punishable under Sections 11, 13(1)(d), 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 (for short 'the Act'); 109, 120B, 409 and 420 of the IPC.

(2) The applicant's first bail application was dismissed on merits by order of this Court dated 16.07.2015 passed in M.Cr.C. No. 3098 of 2015.
