1. The relief sought for by the petitioner is for grant of two advance increments on account of the petitioner having obtained B.Ed. qualification after having come into employment.
2. The counsel for the petitioner submits that the issue raised in the present writ petition has already been decided by this Court in a bunch of writ petitions, which stood allowed 06.12.2013. The leading case being ***WPS No. 6927/2011 (K.K. Dewangan & others v. State of Chhattisgarh & others)*** and other analogous writ petitions. The said order dated 06.12.2013 has been further affirmed by the Division Bench of this Court in W.A. No. 110/2014 and other analogous appeals decided on 04.04.2014.

3. This aspect of the matter having being already adjudicated upon by this High Court and having also being affirmed by the Division Bench is not disputed by the State counsel.
4. In view of the same, the present writ petition stands disposed off with a direction to the respondents that subject to the verification of the facts, the case of the petitioner be also considered in terms of the orders passed by this Court in the case of “**K.K. Dewangan**” (supra) decided on 06.12.2013 along with other bunch of writ petitions.
5. The writ petition accordingly stands allowed and disposed off.
