1. The challenge in the present Writ Petition is to the order [Annexure P/1 dated 05.10.2018](#) whereby the services of the petitioner has been transferred from [Government E. Raghvendra Rao P.G. Science College, Bilaspur to Government Naveen College, Manora, District Jashpur](#).

The petitioner submits that he has already made a detailed representation Annexure P/1 dated 17.11.2018 to the authority concerned seeking a request to the higher authority for canceling the order of transfer dated 05.10.2018, which till date has not been decided. Without entering into the merits of the case, the counsel for the petitioner wants that the petitioner may be permitted to make an additional representation to the respondents raising the objections and grievances on [her being](#) transferred in addition to the representation

already made and the respondents in turn may decide the same as expeditiously as possible.
