PER COURT:-

1. Learned counsel representing the parties submit that the parties to appeal have settled the dispute by filing settlement *pursis* vide exhibit 12 in R.C.A. No.43/2014, which was pending before the District Judge-1, Kandhar, Dist. Nanded. By order dated 25.09.2017 passed by the District Judge-1, Kandhar, the said appeal has been disposed of in terms of compromise *pursis* filed before the said Court.
