1 Though the learned Advocate for the Petitioner has strenuously canvassed his grounds, I find that the Petitioner has a statutory remedy of approaching the State by filing a second revision under Section 257 of the Maharashtra Land Revenue Code in view of the judgment of the Honourable Supreme Court in the matter of *Gurudassing Nawoosing Panjwani vs. State of Maharashtra and others, 2016 (2) SCC 213*.

2 In view of the above, this Writ Petition is disposed of with liberty to avail of the statutory remedy.

3 If such revision is preferred within four weeks from today, the

time spent by the Petitioner in this Court from 12.01.2018 till the passing of this order, would be considered as a ground for condonation of delay.
