ORDER :

- 1] Heard learned counsel appearing for the parties.
- 2] Since it is represented that the applicant no.2 – Archana has attained majority, she is permitted to withdraw an amount of Rs.1,50,000/- from out of the amount deposited by the respondent – insurance company. Such withdrawal shall be upon her filing an undertaking to the effect that the same shall abide by the final orders in this appeal.
- 3] As regards applicant no.3 – Suvarna, as and when she attains majority, liberty to apply for withdrawal of a sum of Rs.1,50,000/- for her.
- 4] The applicant no.1 – Sanjay Changdeo Lahare is permitted to withdraw an amount of Rs.1,00,000/- by filing a similar undertaking as aforesaid.

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5] As regards applicant nos.4 and 5 — Jalindar and Gorakh, who are also stated to have attained majority by now, are permitted to withdraw a sum of Rs.50,000/- each by filing similar undertakings as aforesaid.

6] The balance amount of compensation be invested in any Nationalized bank in a fixed deposit until further orders in the appeal.

7] The civil application is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
