PER COURT :

1. I have heard the learned Advocates for the respective sides.
2. The record reveals that respondent No.1/plaintiff No.1 had in fact, brought the L.Rs. of deceased respondent No.1 on record in Special Civil Suit No. 43/2015 on 06/01/2018, when the said plaintiff had passed away on 13/11/2015.
3. Considering the above, this Civil Application is allowed. The delay of 792 days is condoned and by the consent of the respondents, the applicants shall donate an amount of Rs. 3,000/- as donation for the Government Medical College and

Hospital, Aurangabad, to be deposited with the Medical Officer, High Court Dispensary, Aurangabad, either in cash or by Demand Draft, to be drawn in the name of “Dean, Government Medical College and Hospital, Aurangabad - CSR Fund” on or before 24/08/2018.

4. The L.Rs. of deceased respondent No. 1 shall be brought on record on or before the said date.

5. Learned Advocate causes his appearance on behalf of the L.Rs. in the Civil Revision Application.

7. The ad-interim relief granted earlier, to continue till then.
