PER COURT:-

1. The petitioner and respondent nos. 2,3 and 8 have filed consent terms to dispose of the petition to the extent of respondent nos.2, 3 and 8 in terms of the consent terms. The consent terms are taken on record and marked as 'X' for identification. The respondent nos. 2, 3 and 8 and the person authorised on behalf of the petitioner appeared before the Registrar (Judicial). The Registrar (Judicial) has submitted report after verification as well as identification of the parties.
