PER COURT :-

1 When the present matter is called out, no one has appeared for the appellants.

2 The matter is of the year 2002. The record shows that though time and again the matter was placed for hearing, no one has appeared for the appellants. The appeal, therefore, deserves to be dismissed for want of prosecution. Even otherwise, it appears that by passage of time, the appeal has become infructuous.

3 In the above circumstances, the appeal stands disposed of as became infructuous as well as for want of prosecution.
