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PER COURT :-

1. The petitioner has assailed the order of the Additional Divisional Commissioner dated 6.3.2018, under Section 257 of the Maharashtra Land Revenue Code (MLR Code), which is an order passed in the revision. The Honourable Apex Court has concluded in Gurudassing Nawoosing Panjwani Vs. State of Maharashtra [2015 (6) Mh.L.J. 915], that a statutory second revision proceeding under Section 257 of the MLR Code is available.

2. In view of the above, this petition is disposed off with liberty to the petitioner to avail of such a remedy. If such a revision is filed within four weeks from today, the time spent by the petitioner in this Court from 25.4.2018 shall be considered as a good ground for condonation of delay.
