ORDER :

1. Heard learned counsel for petitioners who fairly refer to that efficacy of present writ petition has been wiped out with further developments taking place in the suit. He, however, purports to point out that initiation of proceedings is in 1988 and since then the plaintiffs have been kept back from the fruits of litigation being enjoyed by them in the event of they succeed. On the contrary matter is getting dragged on at the instance of defendants.
