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PER COURT :-

1 In identical circumstances, writ petition No.9650/2014 has been disposed of with liberty to petitioner to withdraw the amount of Rs.1,00,000/- deposited by the Insurance Company towards full and final settlement of the claims. The instant petition is similar in all respects as that of the disposed matter.
