3. In view of the above, the Commissioner shall consider the representation/objection of petitioners with regard to the transfer and posting within a period of four (04) weeks from today, on its own merits and in accordance with policy. The writ petition is disposed of. No costs.

4. The parties may point out the available vacancies, so also the Zilla Parishad may point out as to whether posting can be made or otherwise.
