PER COURT:-

The petitioner is praying for issuance of directions to the respondents to disburse the amount towards bills in respect of the work done by the petitioner. The liability towards the payment of water supply scheme arises out of the contractual obligations. The petitioner has an alternate remedy available in law. The dispute concerning the contractual obligations need not be entertained under extraordinary jurisdiction under Article 226 of the

Constitution of India. The writ petition is devoid of substance and same stands dismissed with liberty to avail of alternate remedy available in law.
