PER COURT :

1. Petition has been moved seeking direction to respondents to pay amount pursuant to award passed under Section 28-A of Land Acquisition Act dated 28.04.2010.

2. It is not a case wherein the respondents are in a position to deny that, proceedings pursuant to Section 28 A of the Land Acquisition Act had been undertaken and decided on 28.04.2010 albeit it is sought to be contended that there has been reconstitution of officer/s. This would not obviate payment of compensation. It is incumbent and imperative to pay award

amount along with incidental benefits to the petitioner. The amount accordingly be paid to petitioner, if not already paid, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the order by respondents. Writ petition is disposed of.
