Heard Mr. Pradeep Shahane, learned counsel appearing for the applicants, Mr.C.S. Kulkarni, learned AGP appearing for respondents/State and Mr. V.R. Sonwalkar, learned counsel appearing for respondent Nos. 3 and 4.

2. By way of present application, the applicants pray for amendment to the petition. It is submission of Mr. Shahane, learned counsel that there are certain orders passed by the learned Single Judge of this Court in similar circumstances and dealing with and identical issue. He then submitted that the order passed by the learned Single Judge of this Court are confirmed in a proceeding before the Hon'ble the Apex Court. He then submitted that the State Government passed resolution and took a policy decision.
