O R D E R :

Issue notice to the respondents. Learned AGP waives service of notice for respondent no.1.

2. Mr. Chate, learned counsel waives service of notice for respondent nos. 2 to 4.

3. Mr. Kulkarni, learned counsel submits that against the order of Tribunal the petitioner has filed representation but the same is not considered.

4. Mr. Chate, learned counsel submits that authority would decide representation on its own merits.

5. In case representation filed by the petitioner (Exh. E Page 38) is pending with respondent no. 2, then respondent no. 2 shall decide the same, on its own merits, in accordance with law and policy, expeditiously, preferably within four weeks.

6. The writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
