B] The respondent authorities may kindly be directed to complete the process of issuing Mah.Electronic Service Centre at Dhule District in pursuance of the advertisement dated 07.03.2015 and further direct the respondent Nos.2 and 3, to issue license of Mah.Electronic Service Centre in favour of petitioner at

village Dhule, Tq. and Dist. Dhule within a period of one month by issuing writ of mandamus or any other writ in the nature of writ of mandamus.

3] Admittedly, after filing this Petition, an agreement pursuant to the advertisement dated 7th March, 2015, has come to an end in the Year 2016. In that view of the matter, this Petition has rendered infructuous.
