The petitioners / financial institutions are aggrieved by the impugned order dated 20.4.2018, passed by the Deputy Registrar, Cooperative Societies, by which the two applications of the petitioners dated 3.7.2018 in Recovery Application No.452 and 455 of 2009 seeking leave to add the L.Rs. of deceased respondent No.6, have been rejected on the ground that the Recovery Certificate under Section 101 of the Maharashtra Cooperative Societies Act, has already been issued in favour of the petitioners and it can approach the competent authority.
