PER COURT :-

1. By consent, these two writ petitions can be disposed of.

Learned counsel appearing for the parties, on instructions, submits that, the parties have no objection, if, the trial court is directed to dispose off the suit expeditiously, and, till the disposal of the suit, if the parties are directed to maintain status-quo in respect of their respective portion/s of the suit properties.
