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PER COURT :-

1. Issue notice on application for condonation of delay as well as stay. Learned AGP and learned counsel waive service for respective respondents. Service complete.

2. Delay of 887 days and 914 days has occurred in filing the respective appeals by the acquiring body. The reasons are explained in the application. The learned counsel for the respondents has not seriously disputed for condoning the delay. ii. Appeals be registered in accordance with law. On registration of the appeals, issue notice to the respondents. Learned AGP and learned Counsel waive service for respective respondents. Service complete.

3. Execution of the Award impugned in the present appeals shall stand stayed subject to deposit of the entire amount under the Award along with the interest accrued thereon by the acquiring body within a period of twelve weeks from the date of this order. CA for stay stand disposed of.

4. List the appeals for further consideration after 12 weeks.
