PER COURT :

Learned AGP points out that considering the cause of action put forth in this petition upon being aggrieved by the order under Section 81(3)(c) of the Maharashtra Co-Op.Societies Act, these petitioners have a statutory remedy in filing a revision petition under Section 154 of the Maharashtra Co-operative Societies Act.

2. Considering the above, these petitions are disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to prefer the statutory remedy as is available in law. The time spent in this Court from 31/08/2017 till the passing of this order, shall be a good ground for condonation of delay, if any.
