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PER COURT :-

By this petition, the petitioner has challenged grant of certificate under section 38-E of the Hyderabad Tenancy and Agricultural Lands Act, 1950 directly by way of a writ petition.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner informs that the petitioner has also challenged the order dated 21 August 2018 which has preceded the grant of grant certificate. He also states that, stay has been granted in favour of the petitioner in the said appeal. He also

states that, if the appeal is decided in his favour, certificate under section 38 E of the Act would lose its effect. In these circumstances, the relief can be obtained in the appeal. It is thus not necessary to entertain this writ petition. Writ Petition is accordingly disposed of. It is obvious that the petitioner has his remedies open, if the appeal is decided against the petitioner.
